



# DTX Discharge Settings

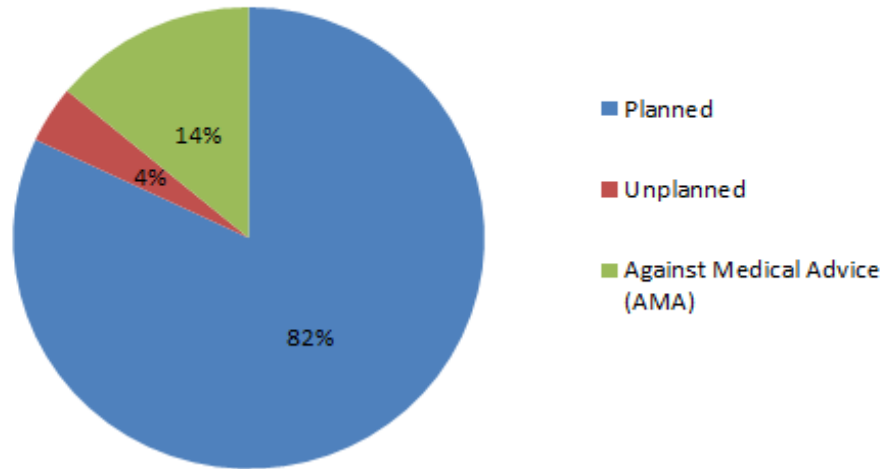
**January 1, 2014 to June 30, 2014**

**Total Discharges: 46**

61% of discharged consumers successfully transitioned back to regular school  
 13% of discharged consumers were referred to a higher level of care (HLOC)

## Types of Day Treatment discharges

January 2014 to June 2014



**Planned discharge** = discharges that were planned by the Child and Family Team

**Unplanned discharge** = discharges that were sudden and/or not planned out by the Child and Family Team

**AMA discharge** = discharges in which the guardian intentionally ended treatment against the advice of clinical staff at Support, Inc.

Average length of stay in treatment (LOS) for consumers who transitioned back to regular school:	211 days
Average LOS for planned discharges:	185 days
Average LOS for AMA or unplanned discharges:	124 days
Average LOS for consumers who were referred to a HLOC:	59 days (23 days is the lowest LOS, and 158 days is the highest LOS)
% involved with social services at program discharge	15%
% involved with the juvenile justice system at program discharge	17%
% of consumers who visited the emergency department 3 months prior to program discharge	6%

**Aggressive behavior experienced, aggressive behavior displayed, and thoughts of self-harm experienced in 3 months prior to program discharge**
