



## *IIHS Discharge Outcomes*

### 1st Quarter FY 2013-2014

**Total discharges this quarter: 43**

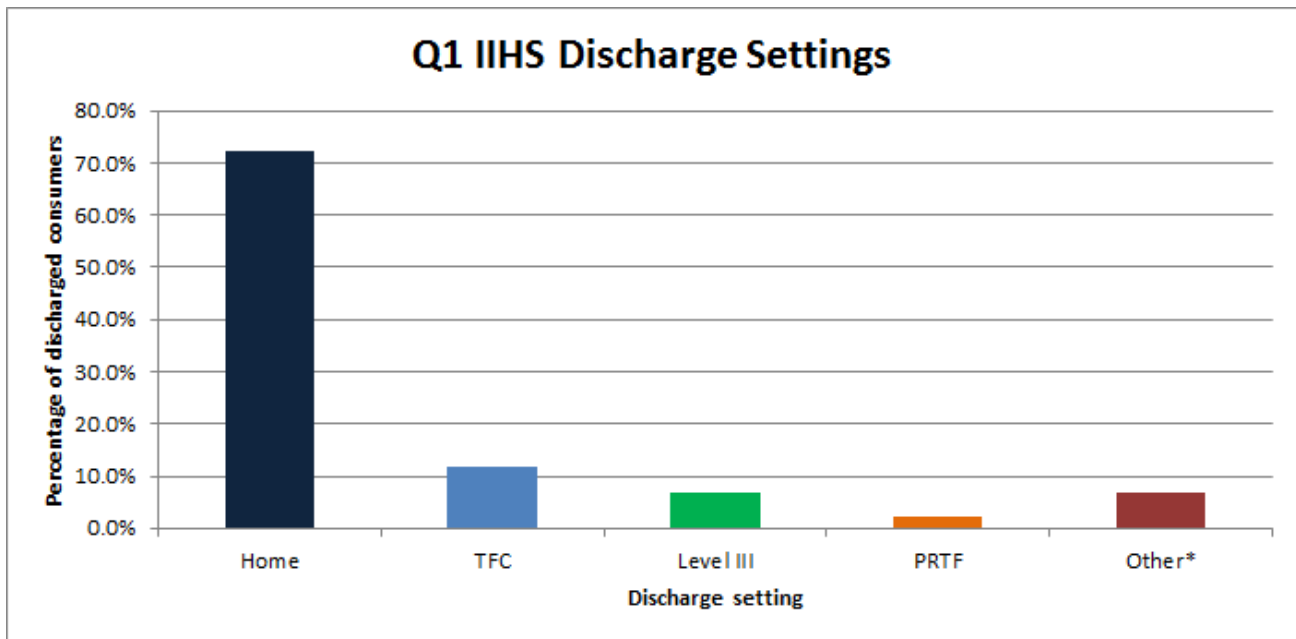
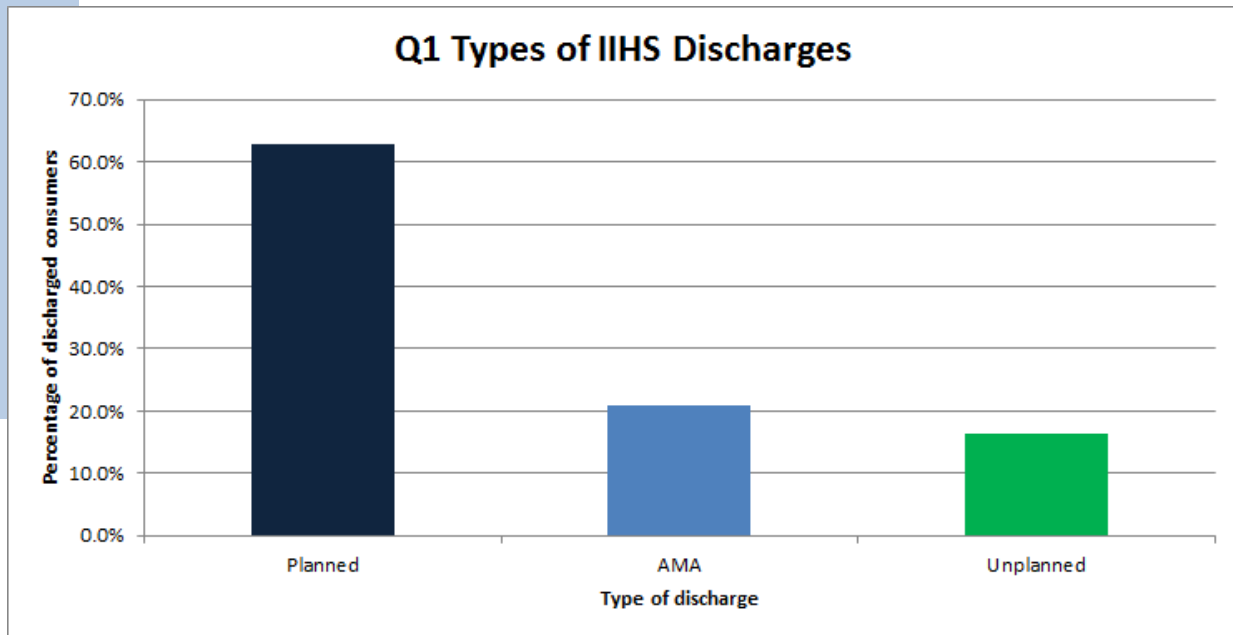
**Total discharges in previous quarter: 57**

72% of discharged consumers remained in the home (78% previous quarter)

28% of discharged consumers were referred to a higher level of care or out of home placement (20.1% previous quarter)
